M.A.W.L. Method Explained

MODEL – Jesus was constantly modeling for His disciples. Before He sent them out to preach the kingdom, heal the sick, or cast out demons they actually saw Him demonstrate these skills.

(Matthew 9:35-10.9,1 Cor. 11:1)



M.A.W.L. Method

ASSIST – When Jesus gave His disciples a task, He would allow them to help as He assisted them.

(Mark 6:35-41, 1 Thess. 3:6)

M.A.W.L. Method

WATCH – When Jesus gave His disciples a task, Jesus would also release His authority to complete the task and then He would watch and evaluate them

(John 4:1-2, 2 Timothy 2:2)



M.A.W.L. Method

LAUNCH – Jesus launched His disciples into the harvest (Matthew 10:1 – 11:1) and ultimately, He left them (Acts 1:7-11) but not without giving them the help and comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4). The Apostle Paul models this as well when he addresses the elders in Ephesus and leaves them in charge of the ministry. (Acts 20:18-28)

M.A.W.L. Method Applied

1. I do. You watch. We talk. (*Model*)
2. I do. You help. We talk. (*Model*)
3. You do. I help. We talk. (*Assist*)
4. You do. I watch. We talk. (*Watch*)
5. You do. Someone else watches.
We talk. (*Launch*)

M.A.W.L. Method: Examples

1. **Bible Study**
2. **Prayer**
3. **Evangelism**
4. **Christian Fellowship**

The Power of Multiplication





Romans 15:19-23


18 For I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me to bring the Gentiles to obedience—by word and deed, 19 by the power of signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God—so that from Jerusalem and all the way around to Illyricum I have fulfilled the ministry of the gospel of Christ; 20 and thus I make it my ambition to preach the gospel, not where Christ has already been named, lest I build on someone else's foundation,

Romans 15:19-23

21 but as it is written, “Those who have never been told of him will see, and those who have never heard will understand.” 22 This is the reason why I have so often been hindered from coming to you.

Romans 15:19-23

23 But now, since I no longer have any room for work in these regions, and since I have longed for many years to come to you, 24 I hope to see you in passing as I go to Spain...
