
Brutal Reality

- ~3.2 million people in Iowa

 - ~30% are Atheist/Agnostic or "nones"
- = 960,000 lost people
- + people who are "cultural Christians"

Why do we make disciples?

How do I begin discipling a brand new believer OR a believer who has never engaged in making disciples?

It makes sense to begin with one of the very last things Jesus told us to do...

Matthew 28:18-20

Every disciple is a disciple-maker.

Read Matt 28:18-20

"Let's break this down one word at a time..."

<u>WHY?</u>- MATT. 28:18-20

JESUS: After dying for our sin and being raised from the grave, Jesus has been given all authority.

Question: Are you committed to follow Jesus as your ultimate authority, your king from this day forward?

WHY?- MATT. 28:18-20



JESUS

GO: Jesus has sent every one of His followers on His mission. He tells us to "go."

Drawing: Arrow

Question: Are you committed be on mission with Jesus, going wherever he sends you?

MAKE DISCIPLES: A disciple of Jesus is a person who follows Jesus, and teaches others how to follow Him. This is our mission and identity.

Drawing: Tree Diagram

Question: Do you accept your new mission and identity as a disciple of Jesus?

ALL NATIONS: Jesus is on a global mission. He wants all people on earth to hear His good news.

Question: Are you committed to be a part of Jesus' global mission?

BAPTIZE: The first step of obedience to Jesus is baptism. This is a powerful symbol showing the world you follow Jesus

Drawing: Water

Question: Where do you want to be baptized today? Who can you invite?

Who should we engage?

Inside left

Now we know our identity and Jesus' mission.

Let's make a prayer map of who He wants us to engage and try to reach for the sake of the gospel.

WHO? (PRAYER MAP) - JOHN 17:20-21


Begin by drawing a circle in the middle of the paper and writing your name in that circle.

Who are 10 people you know that are far from God and need to hear the good news about Jesus?


Put their names in the 10 empty circles



Read: John 17:15-21


Jesus gave us an example of how to pray for generations of disciples. He prayed for His disciples and also for all those who would believe in Him through their testimony.

(Draw "?" connected to each circle)




Imagine what it would look like if God saved one person on your list.


Imagine what would happen to that person's family tree as they begin following Jesus, learning to make disciples, and engage their relational network.



Just like Jesus, let's pray for all these people, and for the generations of people who will believer in Jesus through their testimony.

"There's no sense in pushing a rope."


The 15 Second story is a tool to "take a pulse" with someone to see if there is any interest in having a spiritual conversation.

WHAT? - MY STORY & THE GOSPEL


15 Second Story

Here are the 5 basic parts of sharing your story in 15 seconds or less:

Intro, Before, Jesus, Now, Ask.




You can begin your story by simply saying, "there was a time in my life..."




Think about your life before following Jesus. Write down two words that would describe your life at that time.

Example: "There was a time in my life that I was: <u>depressed</u> & <u>empty</u>"




Next, practice saying a simple statement of faith in Jesus:

"But I turned from my sin and trusted Jesus who died for my sin and is risen!"



Next, think of your life now. What are two words that would describe your life as a follow of Jesus?


Example: "Since I began following Jesus my life, I now have joy and satisfaction in life..."




Finally, you can invite the person into the conversation by asking them something simple like:

"Do you have a story like that?"

(Demonstrate)






Just ask the person,

God's Plan

God has a perfect plan for all of our lives. God's plan is that we would love Him and love others. And this is how the world was in the beginning. Everything was perfect, exactly how God created it.


[Gen. 1:31; Ps 19:1]



SIN

But it didn't take long for people to go their own way. Since the first created people, we have all chosen our own path, instead of living life according to God's plan. Going our own way is called "sin" or rebellion.



Brokenness


When we look around the world today, we can see it is full of brokenness because of our sin. War, murder, hate, disease, addiction, poverty, natural disasters. This was not a part of God's original plan.

[Rom. 1:25; Prov 14:12]



Arrows


No one likes brokenness, so we try to fix it or escape it. Some ways we try to fix or escape from our brokenness are: drugs & alcohol, relationships, money, or just being a good religious person. But these just snap us right back into brokenness.



Jesus

God still has a plan for our lives. He loves us! So to fix our brokenness, God sent His son Jesus down to earth. Jesus never sinned, but died on the cross for our sin. Then He rose from the grave, conquering sin and brokenness!



Turn & Trust Jesus

In order to accept this free gift of Jesus' salvation from our sin and brokenness, we must turn from our sin and trust Jesus as the king (Lord) of our lives.



Free & Follow

Jesus not only forgives us, but frees us from our old life of sin & gives us eternal life! His Spirit in us empowers us to follow Him and GO share this good news with everyone!

[2 Cor. 5:21, Rom 6:20-23; Matt. 4:19]




After showing them the 3 Circles, you want to ask them these questions:

- 1. Does all of this make sense?
- 2. Where are you?


If they say they are in Sin or Brokenness...

3. Is it your desire to turn and trust in Jesus right now?




If the person says "yes, I want to turn and trust Jesus right now," have them pray back through the 3 circles...

"God I know you have a plan for my life, I have sinned, I am broken, I turn and trust in Jesus' death, burial and resurrection; I commit to follow Jesus as Lord."




If the person says "no", ask if they would like to get together again to look at what the Bible says about believing and trusting in Jesus.

(Example of 15 Sec. story + 3 Circles in one conversation)
